

**PUBLIC NOTICE addressed to all those qualified to vote in the
Municipality**

By-law No. 280-2019 – Registration procedure for persons qualified to vote

PUBLIC NOTICE is given to those eligible to vote and who have the right to be registered on the referendum list of the entire Municipality, by the undersigned Secretary-Treasurer of the Municipality of Barnston-Ouest, that:


1. At a council meeting on November 4, 2019, the Municipal Council of Barnston-Ouest passed By-law No. 280-2019 entitled: By-law Decreeing a Maximum Expenditure of \$430,000 and a \$280,000 loan for the construction of a Municipal office.
2. Those wishing to register their name must present an identity card: health insurance card, driver's license, passport, certificate of Indian status, or Canadian Forces ID card.
3. The register will be open from **9:00 am to 7:00 pm** on **November 25, 2019**, at the office of the Municipality of Barnston-Ouest, located at 741 Hunter Road.
4. The number of applications required for By-law No. 280-2019 to be the subject of a referendum is 54. If this number is not reached, By-law No. 280-2019 will be deemed approved by those qualified to vote.
5. The result of the registration process will be announced at 7:05 pm on November 29, 2019, at the Municipal Office of the Municipality of Barnston-Ouest, located at 741 Hunter Road.
6. Citizens can access this by-law at the Municipal office from 8:30 am to 12:00 pm and from 1:00 pm to 4:30 pm Monday to Thursday.

Conditions for being a qualified person to vote with the right to be placed on the referendum list of the entire Municipality:

7. Anyone who, on November 4, 2019, is not disabled to vote under section 524 of the Municipal Elections and Referendums Act and meets the following conditions:
 - Be a natural person living in the Municipality and having lived in Quebec for at least six months, and;
 - Be of age and a Canadian citizen, and not be under curatorship;
8. All sole proprietors of a building or sole occupant of a business establishment who are qualified to vote, and who meets the following conditions:
 - To own a building or sole occupant of a business establishment located in the Municipality for a least 12 months;

- In the case of a natural person, be of full age and a Canadian Citizen, and not be under curatorship.
9. Any undivided co-owner of a building or co-occupant of a business establishment who are qualified to vote, and fulfills the following conditions:
- To be an undivided co-owner of immovable property or co-occupant of a place of business located in the Municipality for at least 12 months;
 - Be designated through a power of attorney signed by a majority of persons who are co-owners or occupants for at least 12 months, such as the one who has the right to sign the register on their behalf and to be registered on the referendum list, where appropriate. This power of attorney must be produced before or during the signature of the register.
10. Corporation
1. Have designated by resolution, among its members, directors or employees, a person who, on or after November 4, 2019, and at the time of exercising this right, is of age and is a Canadian citizen, who is not under curatorship and is not subject to any inability to vote provided by law.
